Resurrection Consequences

1 Corinthians 15:12-34

“For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.” – Romans 1:16

Our passage this morning once again recalls that which is of first importance—the gospel of Jesus Christ. Specifically, though, Paul moves from the truthfulness of Christ’s bodily resurrection in vv.1-11 to the consequences of a bodily resurrection.
